Evening Prior to Surgery

Please do not eat or drink anything after midnight the night before your surgery. This includes water, gum, candy, etc. Please follow these instructions, as they are very important for your safety. If you do not follow these instructions, we may need to delay, cancel and/or reschedule your surgery...unless instructed otherwise by your doctor. Please keep in mind that the time of your surgery may change. A scheduler will call you the day before your surgery with your arrival time.

Morning of Surgery

Please arrive at the time given to you by the surgery center. Upon arrival, you will be asked to complete admission forms and sign consents.

Prior to your surgery, you will meet with your anesthesiologist, and pre-operative nurse, and you will have the opportunity to ask any last minute questions.

Leave all valuables at home. You will be asked to remove all jewelry, contact lenses, etc., and therefore, we recommend that all valuables be left at home.

Wear loose, casual, comfortable clothing that will fit over your postoperative dressing.

You must plan to have someone drive you home. If you plan to use taxis or other public transportation, make sure you have an adult to accompany you. A friend, relative or dedicated caregiver must stay with you after surgery for 24 hours. We are required to discharge you with a responsible adult who is with you (it cannot be a cab driver).

Information to bring: Insurance cards, photo ID, Medicare or medical assistance information, numbers and addresses, and health care advance directive if you have one.

You may receive a phone call from a health history nurse prior to your surgery to collect information about your health to expedite your admission process. If you do not receive a phone call by 3pm the day before your surgery, please give our center a call at 510-576-8500.

Things to Remember

- By now you have discussed your procedure with your surgeon. Please communicate all questions and concerns with your surgeon in order to assure your satisfaction prior to your surgery.
- Notify the center and your surgeon if you have an elevated temperature, cough, cold, vomiting or diarrhea between your last visit to the surgeon and the day of your surgery. You suspect you may be pregnant.
- If you take medications please bring a list, including homeopathic remedies.
- Please bathe or shower the night before or the morning of your surgery.
- No smoking after midnight the night before your surgery.
- Do not drink alcoholic beverages at least 24 hours prior to surgery.
- Do not eat or drink anything after midnight prior to surgery.
- Surgery time is unpredictable, and you may end up waiting longer than anticipated. You may want to bring a book or magazine.
- Please be advised that our facility's hours do vary based on surgery schedule. If you have questions or concerns and are unable to reach us, please contact your surgeon's office.
